


We Believe...

Our Credentials...



Pastor-Dr. Ben E. Andrews accepted the call of the Holy Spirit and began preaching the Word of God in May of 1974. He was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel in 1976.

He received his Bachelors Degree in Theology in 1977. He received his Doctorate in Theology from The Lord's Outreach of Theology in 2018.

He and his wife, Minister Joyce Andrews, founded Holy Bible Faith Center in June of 1989. He still holds the position of Senior Pastor of the church.

Minister Joyce Andrews, noted and respected Biblical author and historian, served as the Minister of Education until her untimely passing early in 2021. She authored many papers and published three books while lecturing extensively on her findings. She was an ordained minister and can still be seen on her television show, “You Are “Star Right Where You Are”, which airs in Beaumont.

She received her BS Degree in Theology while continuing to teach and write. Her other two books, “Bible Legacy of the Black Race,” and “The Lost Legacy of Ham,” along with “You Are A Star Right Where You Are” are available through Holy Bible Faith Center.



Dr. Yolanda G. Duriso, PH.D., President and Chancellor, has studied under Pastor and Minister Andrews since 1989. A gift that Dr. Duriso has repeatedly demonstrated in the body of Christ is the gift of teaching. She presently teaches Sunday School, Morning Bible Study and all classes offered by the church. She has also taught theology classes at The Lord's Outreach School of Theology for over two years.

She has received a Doctorate in Theology Doctorate of Divinity and is a MS Certified Christian Counselor.



Dr. Bobby Brumley, Vice President and Asst. Chaneclor of the school, is also an ordained minister at the Holy Bible Faith Center church. He received his Doctorate Degree in Theology in 2019 from The Lord's Outreach School of Theology. Dr. Brumley is the Assistant Youth Minister at the church and he also a Sunday School teacher.

He is very active in the ministry and has been an instructor with the school from the very beginning.

Goals, Policies and Regulations of HBFC School of Theology...

August 20, 2021

1. Our school will be known for encouraging it's students to be the best and achieve all that God has called them to do in their ministry, to make a Godly difference in their environment.
2. We will encourage each student to attend church regularly and have a church home to work in ministry at their local church and abroad.
3. Our goal is to encourage all students to read their Bibles in the morning and at night, and do what the Bible says to achieve success and prosperity to benefit the body of Christ and to get souls saved; Joshua 1:8.
4. We encourage our students to testify regularly in their local church and abroad, of their blessings from the Lord. This will encourage others to seek God.
5. We will encourage our students to treat others as they want to be treated.
6. We will teach our students to speak and dress appropriately as always representing Christ Jesus.
7. We will teach our students to always be apt to teach and/or render words as requested and needed, when asked.
8. We will teach our students to speak only for the time designated and no longer. Be professional. Look professional. State their topic, support the topic and end with teaching the cross.

Policy and Regulations

1. All faculty and students will conduct themselves in a Christ-like manner at all times, whether in school or in public. We represent Jesus our Savior.
2. All faculty and students must dress appropriately. Men attending school or teaching will wear long pants. Men and women will not wear tank tops or thongs. Men can wear sandals worn with socks or closed toe shoes.

3. All ladies are asked to wear dresses or skirts below the knees or long dark pants. Ladies, no tank tops.
4. All students must have their Bibles and class materials in every class session.
5. Every student is asked to bring a bottle of water to quench their thirst or clear their throats as needed to stay hydrated.
6. All fees must be paid prior to the first day of class.
7. All faculty will be paid after class.
8. Everyone is asked to be on time for class so that we can complete all of our required hours and save time.
9. If there is a complaint against a faculty member or a student, please submit your complaint in writing the same day of the incident to Pastor Andrews or President Duriso, with a delay of no longer than three (3) days. Our policy is to address and resolve all complaints as quickly as possible.
10. If you must leave class please notify your instructor and quietly exit. You may send a text message to Dr. Duriso-409-466-1744 or Dr. B. Andrews-409-466-5002.
11. If you attend an hour of class there is no refund of the registration fee on the first day of class, your preparation work has already been done. You will pay for the hour you attended. The instructor must be paid for his or her time in class.
12. The financial committee of the church will oversee and advise Theology staff as needed.
13. A degree will not be issued unless a student has met all requirements. All tests, essays etc. must be completed as designated by your instructor to receive your desired degree. A passing grade of 75 minimum is required.
14. All test must be submitted within 10 business days after end of class.
15. All students will be taught how to teach a 15 minute lesson during the month of March.
16. To complete degree requirements, each student will be required to give a 15 minute lesson. Presenting topic, scripture, supporting body to teach the

lesson, ending with the preaching of the cross. This presentation will be done in March each year.

17. To complete your degree plan, each student will be required to know all 66 books of the Bible and their divisions.
18. If you have questions about the goals, policies and regulations of this school, please make an appointment or submit a letter promptly, to meet with the President and/or Pastor.
19. If a student fails to participate in the required 15 minute message at the end of the class, 10 points will be deducted each time.

Registration fee plus 1st degree payment will be due on or before the first day of class. The remaining balance can be broken into nine equal payments. Example: AA Degree for a new student- 1st payment will be \$65.00 plus \$135.00 = \$200.00 due on first day. This leaves a balance of \$1,150.00 with monthly payments of \$135.00. Students do have the option of paying total degree fees at the time of registration.

All fees must be satisfied before graduation.
